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Classroom Consequences

Below are suggestions for classroom consequences. Teachers should choose an appropriate consequence for the behavior. Documentation of the incident and the consequence is encouraged in the event administrative action becomes necessary.

First Offense

Proximity Control
Nonverbal cue to correct behavior
Warning (Verbal or Written)/ Behavior Correction

Second Offense

Last to leave room
Seat change
Parent Contact
Detention
Time Out In the Classroom
Minor Incident Slip
Write apology

Third Offense

Parent Contact
Write essay about incident
Time Out in Buddy Room

Fourth Offense

Parent Contact & Referral
